

***Announcing
the 2016 Agnese Nelms Haury Scholarship at
Linacre College, Oxford University, United Kingdom***

This Native American and First Nations scholarship provides support (tuition fees and living costs) for indigenous students from the United States and Canada to study for a one-year taught Masters degree at Oxford University (www.ox.ac.uk) in the United Kingdom in association with Linacre College (www.linacre.ox.ac.uk). Linacre College is an interdisciplinary and international graduate college in Oxford University.



Eligibility: Students must apply and gain admission to one of the designated Masters programs at Oxford University and be an enrolled tribal member with official status in the US (state or federal) as American Indian, Alaska Native, or in Canada as First Nation, Metis, or Inuit.

Deadlines: The deadlines for applications for entry in fall 2016 are 08 or 22 January 2016, depending on the program.
